“Living with Dying”

Sister Rosemary Flanigan, Ph.D.

Many recognize Sister Rosemary Flanigan from TV commercials for Carondelet Health Corporation however during the past 13 years she has been an integral part of the Center for Practical Bioethics. She directed the Ethics Committee Development and Education at Midwest Bioethics Center before its transformation to the Center of Practical Bioethics.
