El Refugio Children's Home continues to house, educate, and vocationally train abandoned and needy children in Honduras. The compound has a nurse with a first aid room, library, game room, covered outdoor athletic area, bakery, welding shop, sewing center, computer room, classrooms, dormitories, and cafeteria. The compound was clean and adorned with pretty plants and flowers.

The children are friendly and seem very well adjusted for some of their life experiences. As we drove up a young boy was brushing his teeth at the water spigot so our health teaching is implemented.

Health teams usually visit once a year to do physical and dental exams on all the children. Additional teams may stop by for one day to follow-up on any specific needs.
