Happy, Healthy Smiles at Scarritt Elementary

Happy, Healthy Smiles was my theme as I visited the Scarritt Elementary School in Kansas City, Missouri. I enjoyed sharing basic home care instructions for good dental health with two classes of culturally diverse beautiful children in their afterschool health program, headed by Paula Rummel, RN.

During the session, my son Chris Allen assisted me in showing two CD's on a laptop computer. The first featured two small dogs in "Andy's First Visit to a Dental Office". Later the children watched, Kirby, a real chimpanzee, learn how to brush his teeth. With the help of a puppet crocodile, we reviewed the "2 X 2" reminder to brush at least twice a day for at least two minutes each. The children enjoyed watching the crocodile spit water from his mouth after swishing. Each child received a bag of toothpaste, toothbrush, floss, and an apple, (an example of a 'healthy' snack) to take home.

In over thirty years as a dental hygienist, I found these young students at Scarritt Elementary to be the most attentive and respectful that I can remember! Hopefully, they were encouraged to take good care of their teeth. I wish for them a lifetime of Happy, Healthy Smiles!
