### SITE VISIT TO GUATEMALA

HMA and Outreach International are planning a site visit to Guatemala May 23-30, 2009. The first 15 people to register for the trip will get to go.

Visitors will meet the local nurses trained by Ruth and the villagers impacted by the participatory human development process through training by Outreach International. Visitors will see the tilapia fish farm, newly constructed homes and chapina stoves, ecofilters, and tire gardens all implemented by the people themselves with the help of Ruth, Amilcar, the Guatemalan nurses, and Health Ministries Association members and donors.

The trip will include sight-seeing in Antigua, a tour of a coffee farm and Mayan ruins in the area. Consideration should be made for walking on rough terrain and limited access to amenities.
