Community of Christ Health Ministries
Association members has been serving people
for nearly 50 years. Medical teams and other
collaborations share knowledge, expertise, and
expand ministry horizons through "association"
with other professionals who have similar
interests and goals. As we have engaged in
worthwhile activities, we have created bonds of
friendship but more importantly, we have
brought ministry and healing.

Organizational Impact

Wilfredo is now 16 years old. In 2010 he had the proud moment of graduating 6th grade in Boquito, Honduras. Wilfredo was born with a



cleft lip and palate. He had not been able to start 1st grade like the other six year olds because the teacher and villagers thought he was stupid. Pediatrician Bob Paschall saw him on a mission team 10 years ago and referred him to Operation Smile, an organization HMA intro-

duced to Honduras. After his reconstructive surgeries, Wilfredo was allowed to attend school and to have a future.

Congregational Impact

In Independence, MO Beacon Heights Congregation is being the hands and feet of Jesus ministering through Care Groups in the Health Ministries Team. "As powerful as prayer is, it is not enough just to put people on the prayer list", states Diane Rogers Team Coordinator. Diane is committed to Congregational Health Ministry because of the concepts taught at the

course offered by HMA several years ago. "A meal delivered, a ride to the doctor when they can't drive, help planning a memorial service, or respite care-giving all can be offered in the spirit of ministry. Attending HMA's training helped me realize the interconnectedness of the body, mind, and spirit and how ministry needs to incorporate all aspects of a person". Diane continued, "Prayer is an integral part of supporting each other but ministry is also 'hands-on'." HMA provides resources and encourages HMA members ministering in their congregations and to their communities.

Individual Impact

Since HMA doctors and nurses have had a long-standing relationship with Haiti, it was only natural for Don Potts and Ron Edwards, MD's and HMA members to volunteer their time and skills to the victims of Haiti after last January's earthquake. These HMA members volunteered with Heart to Heart International offering their medical services since HMA does not have the infrastructure in Haiti to support disaster relief.

Dr. Potts returned on a second medical team to assist Haitians in January. "Many have described the immense devastation and need there but the gratitude of the people continues to touch my heart", stated Dr. Potts.



Health professionals and persons passionate about health are encouraged to join HMA and encourage health promotion in congregations and communities. Together we can minister to the bruised and broken-hearted knowing that when we have ministered to the least of these, we have ministered to Jesus Christ.
